Fire Extinguishers & Blankets...

A timely reminder with winter just around the corner.... All heater appliances must have heat guards and caution signs – or be located well out of the reach of customers. Where gas appliances are used, stallholders are to provide their own firefighting equipment which, as a minimum, should comprise a powder ABE 2 kg fire extinguisher and fire blanket. You should also ensure all cables and power boards are checked and tagged.

Should you notice that the list is incorrect or you would like to add additional produce lines, approval needs to be requested from the Market Manager together with consideration of the CRFM Committee.
