Electrical Equipment - CRFM Rules...

A timely reminder as winter gradually approaches that it's nearly 12 months since our last round of testing and tagging. It is a requirement of our contract with EPIC that we are compliant with WHS according to the Work Health & Safety Act 2011 (ACT) and failure to do so puts us (CRFM) in breach of our contract with potential for termination.

All electric power cords and electrical appliances must be 'tested and tagged' annually by a licensed inspector in accordance with ACT legislative requirements.

If you only have 1 or 2 leads the cost should be around \$7.50 per lead, for any more than that it may cost \$100 + GST but that covers you for up to 10 leads; these are last year's prices, it may be a little more expensive this year. If you need details of local licensed inspectors, please let me know.
