23rd December - Bump-in Details

In preparation for Summernats, please remember to help out on the 23rd by bumping in and out in an orderly manner and ensuring you leave your site as tidy as possible on departure. Hazard lights must be on when entering and leaving the shed and vehicles moving no faster than walking pace. There will be a lot of traffic vacating the shed after the market on the 23rd... always remember, safety first.

Please let your customers know about the changes to entry and trading hours for the 23rd December:

- Bump-in will commence at 2.30am for our bigger stallholders, those that stay overnight on the Friday, and those that take several hours to set up.
- All the other stallholders can bump-in from 4am onwards. If you arrive before 4am you will be asked to wait until it is clear for you to enter the site. The bigger stallholders use forklifts to unload pallets and equipment from their trucks and need space to do this
- Stallholders and general public entrance will only be via Old Well Station Rd Gates and Gate 7 (Gate 7 is by the toilet block at the carpark)
- We ask that everyone is ready to trade by 6.30am as gates will open to the general public at 6.30am.
- All vehicles are to be parked on the grass area behind
- CRFM gates will open to the general public at 6.30am
- All stallholders are to cease trading at 11am.

We are required to hand the site back to Summernats by 1pm.

Welcome Willayoung Orchard

Willavoung is a family owned and operated property specialising in tree ripened stone fruit. Andrew and Helen begin picking in late November and run through until early April.

Situated near Young, Willayoung consists of over 5,500 trees on approximately 8 hectares (20 acres). Purchased in 1988 there were only a couple of fruit trees in the house yard. After initially operating as a fruit-tree nursery (with a small number of 'hobby' fruit trees) there has been a transition to full orchard operation. The final stage of this transition was the establishment of a packing shed in 2002.
