EPIC UPDATES

Some good news regarding road works. Stage 1, the intersection at Old Well Station and Federal Highway will be signalised and the section of road from Federal Highway to Canberra Park will be widened – including a bike path. This will occur post National Folk Festival 2018.

Stage 2, which will be from Canberra Park to Morrissett, is proposed within the next financial year.

EPIC has also updated the entry way, gates and signage at Old Well Station Rd.



23rd December - Bump-in Details

Due to Summernats security and taking charge of the venue, there have been restrictions placed on CRFM for the last market of the year.

I have outlined what you will need to know for the 23rd Dec:

- CRFM trading hours will strictly be 6.30am to 11am
- There will be no access into EPIC on Friday 22nd December
- Stallholders and general public entrance will only be via Old Well Station Rd Gates and Gate 7 (Gate 7 is by the toilet block at the carpark)
- Anyone arriving before their allocated bump-in time, will be asked to wait
- Gate 7 will open to the general public at 6.30am

- Stallholders are asked to park their vehicles behind the shed (back of Café) and obey all traffic management directions
- Stallholders to cease trading at 11am.

We are required to hand the site back to Summernats by 1pm and ask that everyone leave their sites free from any rubbish. Please let your customers know of the changed trading hours and entry to CRFM.

We will also have signs and flyers printed in the next week to let our customers know.
