### Late Payment Admin Fee.

As you can appreciate, late payments have been an ongoing administrative liability and a matter in need of urgent attention.

Because of this, the committee has directed that from **7 May 2018, a \$20 Late Payment Admin Fee** is to be automatically issued to any stallholder whose stall fee is not received by Thursday night - prior to Saturday market.

**I recommend you schedule an automatic EFT early in the week, to ensure your stall fee is in CRFM account by Thursday night at the latest.**

### Arboretum markets.

There may be an opportunity for CRFM to hold additional markets at the National Arboretum if we get sufficient stallholder numbers.

The proposed markets would be held over the weekends of Summernats, National Folk Festival and Canberra Show.

Open to growers and producers, this would be an open-air market with no cover, and restricted to stallholders that do not require electricity.

If you're interested and have a marquee, please let me know.

### Defibrillator

CRFM has purchased a defibrillator. This will be stored in the office. Both Nienke and I have our First Aid Certificate and have been trained on how to use the defib'. If there are any stallholders that have done their first aid training, please let me know so I can keep a list.

### Road Closures. Please Let Your Customers Know

Commencing 7 May, there will be no access onto Old Wells Station Rd from Federal Highway.

The section of road between Federal Highway turn off and Canberra Park (accommodation) will be closed due to road works.

There will be entry into the market via Gate 4 – (Sterling Av - MacDonald's and service station) until 5.30am Saturday.

The entries off Morisset Rd (shipping containers) and the main EPIC entrance off Old Wells Station Rd will be accessible.

Signage and traffic management will be used to direct the public over several Saturdays - but as always, it's much appreciated if you can help spread the word to your customers.
