### Market Philosophy

To maintain Market authenticity, neither produce nor products obtained from wholesalers, retailers or other unauthorised persons may be offered, traded or exchanged on Market premises. It is critical to the Market's authenticity that this Rule applies *at all times*, noting that deliberate breaches of this Rule will incur the severest penalty of being immediately and permanently expelled from the Market.

### Retiring or selling?

Just a reminder to anyone thinking of retiring or planning to sell their business; there is no "ownership" of Market stalls, and they are non-transferable.

The right to operate in the Market ceases on any change in ownership. If the new owner wants to come into the Market, a new application will be required and it will then be judged against the

Market Rules. This also applies if you sell a share of your business.

If in doubt, or you have any questions, ask the Manager.

### Friday Bump-in.

Revisiting this old chestnut.....

Stallholders are not to bump-in before 12pm Friday. Any stallholder found to set up before 12pm on Friday, will have Friday bump-in revoked.

This is an agreement we negotiated with EPIC and it would be a shame if a handful of stallholders ruin it for everyone else.
